Supplementary Regulations for a three discipline motorsport weekend

- Circuit Sprint
- Motorkhana
- Autocross

### 1. JURISDICTION

These are Clubsport Basic events promoted by the Manawatu Car Club (0361).

These events are held under the MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules.

### 3. VENUE

Manfeild Park Feilding. Surface is sealed.

Circuit Sprints will be held on the 3.03km circuit

Trial will be held on public roads around Feilding

Motokhana and Autocross will be held on the combined 4.5km of sealed track

### 4. ENTRIES & FEES

Saturday and Sunday	Sprint, Motorkhana and Autocross	\$100

Sunday only	Motorkhana and Autocross	\$80

Entries by Wednesday 1st November 2017.

Late entries are accepted on the day up to 9.00am on both Saturday and Sunday.

### 5. ELIGIBILITY & LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

**5.1 Driver Eligibility:** To participate in the Multi Event Weekend competitors must be a member of a MSNZ affiliated club, **UNLESS** they are entering their first or second event where no MSNZ club membership or competition licence is required.

## 5.2 Classes:

NARWD	Normally aspirated rear-wheel-drive
NAFWD	Normally aspirated front wheel drive
FI+NA 2WD over 3800cc	Forced induction and normally aspirated two-wheel-drive over 3800cc
Rookie	New to motorsport competition in 2017

## 5.3 Vehicle Eligibility

- 1) For Circuit Sprint All vehicles must conform to Schedule A. Safety.
- 2) For Motorkhana and Sealed Autocross all vehicles shall, as a minimum, be to a warrantable standard, with a securely mounted seat, safe steering and effective brakes. The Clerk of the Course has discretionary powers as to the type of vehicle deemed suitable for the venue.
- 3) To qualify for Overall points competitors must drive the same vehicle for the Circuit Sprint, the Motorkhana and the Sealed Autocross

## 6 PASSENGERS

**Circuit Sprint and Autocross:** Passengers may only be carried in a car with MSNZ homologated full roll cage. Safety gear and apparel must be as per Schedule A. All passengers must sign the passenger indemnity form in the office and wear the wristband provided. The scrutineer is to inspect the passenger seat and harness for compliance with Schedule A.

## 7. DOCUMENTATION, AUDIT SCRUTINEERING & DRIVERS BRIEFING

Documentation for the Circuit Sprint will commence at 8am and end at 9.30am on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> in the Track Office at Manfeild.

Documentation for the Motorkhana and Autocross will commence at 8am and end at 9am on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> at the track office at Manfeild.

Scrutineering will take place in the Scrutineering Shed at Manfeild on Saturday from 8am to 9.30am and on Sunday from 8am to 9am. Audits as per MSNZ requirements.

Entry to the track will be via Rata Street.

**Drivers briefing** will take place at 9.30am on Saturday and 9.00am on Sunday at the Starters Podium in Pit Lane.

## 8. FIRST AID & FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

The Medical Officer will be stationed in the track office in the Pit Lane Complex. The medical vehicle will be parked on Pit Lane directly outside the office

Fire Extinguishers will be at the Start Line, and at nominated points around the course according to the safety plan.

## 9. THE EVENTS

**The Sprint** will be three flying laps of the 3.03km circuit.

- Competitors line up on the dummy grid and will be released at 10 second intervals for the warm-up lap and will cross the start line at speed for a flying start.
- At the end of the third lap the driver will be shown the chequered flag to end the run.
- The driver will complete a full cool-down lap, exit the circuit and run down the full length of the pit lane and into the paddock to pit.
- The first three runs per competitor will be timed. The best run counts.

**NOTE: The Sprint event is also Round 3 of the 2017 Manawatu Toolshed Track Day Sprint Series. By entering Competitors may accumulate points for both the Multi Event and the Sprint Series.**

**The Motorkhana** will be a series of four low-speed tests marked out with road cones.

- The time starts from the start box and ends with the vehicle stationary in the finish box.
- A knocked over cone adds 5sec to the competitor's time.
- Three runs per test per competitor will be timed. The best run per test counts towards overall time.

**The Autocross** is a run of approximately 4.5kms of the full Manfeild sealed track from a flying start.

- Cars will leave the pit exit then negotiate the circuit anti-clockwise or opposite the usual track direction.
- Competitors will negotiate road cone chicanes set up in compliance with Appendix 5 Schedule C 2.1(1).
- The run ends with a flying finish and exit back to the paddock via the Pit Exit.

- Up to four vehicles may be running at any one time at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
- A knocked over cone adds 5sec to the competitor's time.
- The first three runs per competitor will be timed. The best run counts.

**Note: All three events must be completed in the same vehicle to score points.**

**Multiple Drivers** of the same car is permitted. Drivers must ensure the correct number is displayed and the correct transponder is fitted to the car before starting a run.

## 10. POINTS STRUCTURE, TIMING, AND RESULTS.

Points for the Multi Event Weekend will be awarded on the following basis per discipline:

1 <sup>st</sup>	10 points	6 <sup>th</sup>	5 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	9 points	7 <sup>th</sup>	4 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	8 points	8 <sup>th</sup>	3 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	7 points	9 <sup>th</sup>	2 points
5 <sup>th</sup>	6 points	10 <sup>th</sup>	1 point

The driver with the most points accumulated from the three events will be the winner. In the case of a tie, the driver with the most 1<sup>st</sup> places wins. In the case of a further tie the most 2<sup>nd</sup> places, then 3<sup>rd</sup> places and so on will determine the winner.

The Circuit Sprint and Autocross will be timed by AMB transponder. Results will be available from the timing room on the day

The Motorkhana will be timed by stopwatch.

The leader board will be updated on a laptop at the track. Final results will be posted on the notice board and on the website [www.manawatucarclub.org.nz](http://www.manawatucarclub.org.nz)

## 11. PRIZE GIVING

Will be held in the HFT Suite at the conclusion of the Sealed Autocross.

Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place of each class and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall along with Fastest Woman Driver and other prizes decided by the organisers.

The purpose of the Multi-Event Weekend is to promote entry-level participation in motorsport. This is both for the experienced enthusiast and those who are new to the sport. The emphasis is on fun and enjoyment. Anyone 12 years and over can have a go.
