MANFEILD 4.5KM SEALED AUTOCROSS

Supplementary Regulations for Sealed Autocross Saturday 17th June 2018

1. JURISDICTION

This is a Clubsport Basic event promoted by the Manawatu Car Club (0361).

This event is held under the MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code Appendix 5, Schedule C.

3. VENUE

Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon 4.5km circuit, Feilding. Surface is sealed.

4. ENTRIES & FEES

The entry fee is \$90 inc GST. Entries are preferred by Wednesday 13th June 2018.

Entries are accepted on the day up to 9.00am. There is no late fee.

Late documentation and scrutineering maybe carried between 12 and 12.30pm at the discretion of the organiser.

5. CLASSES, ELIGIBILITY & LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Classes:

- Rookie (new to competition in 2018)
- NARWD- normally aspirated rear-wheel-drive
- NAFWD- normally aspirated front-wheel-drive
- FI + NA2WD over 3500cc- forced induction vehicles and normally aspirated 2 wheel-drive over 3500cc
- Overall

5.2 Eligibility: All cars must comply with Schedule A Safety. Road cars with current registration and WOF are permitted. BOS cars are permitted.

5.3 Licences

- i) No MSNZ licence is required.
- ii) No MSNZ membership is required if you have competed at 2 events or fewer. New competitors are to enter the Rookie class.
- iii) Drivers 12years and older are eligible to compete with parental consent.

6. PASSENGERS. Passengers may ONLY be carried in a car with MSNZ homologated full roll cage by a driver with a competition licence.

Passenger safety apparel must conform with Appendix 2, Schedule A 4.3. Protective Clothing. All passengers must sign the passenger indemnity form in the office and wear the wristband provided.

7. DOCUMENTATION, AUDIT SCRUTINEERING & DRIVERS BRIEFING

Documentation will commence at **0800** and finish at **0930 at the Manfeild Track Office, ground floor of the Pit Lane Complex.**

Late documentation as per point 4.

Scrutineering will take place in the Scrutineering Shed on the Dummy Grid. Audits as per MSNZ requirements. All cars without a Competition Vehicle Logbook must be audited. Audits will take place on the day from 0800 to 0930.

Entry to the track will be via the Rata Street entrance and the South Street entrance.

Drivers briefing will take place at the Start Line in pit lane at **0930 and is compulsory for all competitors.**

8. FIRST AID & FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

First aid Officer will be stationed in pit lane adjacent to the starter's podium.

4.5kg powder Fire Extinguishers will be at the Start Line, at nominated points around the course and in the recovery vehicles.

9. RUNS

The Autocross will be one lap of the 4.5 km track from a flying start and will end in a flying finish. The morning runs will be in a clockwise direction and the afternoon runs will be counter-clockwise. Competitors will negotiate chicanes positioned in compliance with Appendix 5 Schedule C 2.1(1). Up to three vehicles may be running at any one time but at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

A knocked over cone adds 5sec to the competitor's time. Up to three runs per competitor will be timed in each direction. The best single run counts. Additional runs will not count towards the results.

Competitors will complete a sighting run in single file behind the course car before the morning and afternoon runs

Results will be based on the aggregate of the best morning and the best afternoon run.

Special Prize: The driver who has the closest time between the best clockwise and anti-clockwise runs will be awarded a special prize by the organisers.

10. RESULTS.

Timing will be by AMB transponder. These will be issued to drivers at documentation. There is no hire charge and they must be returned at the conclusion of the event.

Running results will be posted on MyLaps Speedhive live timing app.

Final results will be posted on the website www.manawatucarclub.org.nz

11. PRIZE GIVING

Prize giving will be held at the Refueller Bar at the conclusion of competition.

12. PITS GARAGES AND PARKING.

Competitor parking and pits are in the Manfeild paddock area. The stable pit bays are free and are available on a first-in-first-served basis. Garage hire is available. Please contact Jeff Braid 027 4773337 for details. Spectator parking is in the Rata Street paddock.

13. SPECTATOR ADMISSION AND VIEWING

Spectator admission is free. Viewing is from the Manfeild spectator stands. No dogs are allowed and children must be kept under control at all times.
