BACK TRACK AUTOCROSS/ MOTORKHANA

Supplementary Regulations for Sealed Autocross and Motorkhana Sunday August 18th 2019

1. JURISDICTION

These are Clubsport Basic events promoted by the Manawatu Car Club (0361). This event is held under the MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code Appendix 5- Schedule C. **MotorSport New Zealand Clubsport Basic Permit Number: 190448**

3. VENUE

Manfeild Park 1.5km Back-Track, Feilding. Surface is sealed. Entry to the track will be via the Manawatu Car Club clubrooms, 120 Kawakawa Road Feilding.

4. ENTRIES & FEES

The entry fee is \$90 inc GST. Manawatu Car Club members receive a \$10 discount

Entries are accepted on the day up to 9.00am.

Late documentation and scrutineering may be carried between 12 and 12.30pm at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

5. CLASSES, VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY & LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Classes:

- Rookie new to competition in 2019
- NARWD
- NAFWD
- FI + NA2WD over 3500cc

5.2 Vehicle Eligibility: All vehicles must comply with Schedule A Safety. Road cars, BOS cars and competition cars are welcome.

5.3 Licence Requirements. This is a Clubsport Basic event

- No MSNZ licence is required.
- MSNZ affiliated club membership is required **unless** you have competed at 2 events or fewer.

5.4 Protective Clothing: All apparel and helmets must comply with Schedule A. For the Autocross 100% cotton or better flameproof overalls with close-fitting cuffs and collar must be worn. It is advisable that full length 100% cotton or 100% wool or better underwear is worn, along with 100% cotton or 100% wool or better socks and leather shoes. Garments or shoes made of predominantly flammable material, such as nylon are not permitted under any circumstance.

5.4 Passengers. Autocross passengers may only be carried in a car with MSNZ homologated full roll cage. All passengers must be over 12years old, sign the passenger indemnity form and wear the same or better safety apparel as the driver.

6. DOCUMENTATION, AUDIT SCRUTINEERING & DRIVERS BRIEFING

Documentation will commence at 0800 on the day of the round and finish at 0900 in the Manawatu Car Club Clubrooms.

Late documentation as per point 4.

Scrutineering will take place in the car park at the Manawatu Car Club clubrooms 120 Kawakawa Road from 0800 to 0900. Audits will be done as per MSNZ requirements. All cars without a Competition Vehicle Logbook must be audited. The scrutineers will be paying attention to battery mounts, positive battery terminal insulation, seats and seatbelts, driver's door card, helmets and overalls.

Drivers briefing will take place at 0915 at the start line at and is compulsory for all competitors.

7. RUNS

The Motorkhana: There are three low speed tests. Competitors will get a practice run and a maximum of two timed runs per test. The best time will count towards the overall points. The whole group will move from one test to the next test once all have completed their runs. Helmets and overalls are not required for these tests

The Autocross will be two laps of the back track from a standing start. Competitors will negotiate road cone chicanes set up in compliance with Appendix 5 Schedule C 2.1(1). The run will end with the car stationary in the coned 'garage'.

Before official runs begin all competitors will be led on a 'tiki tour' sighting run in single file.

Up to three vehicles may be running at any one time at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Competitors will get a practice run and a maximum of three timed runs in clockwise direction. The single best time counts. The lowest times determine the winners. Any additional runs will not count for the competition.

Penalties: Knocking over a marker cone adds 5 seconds to the competitor's time.

8. RESULTS.

Timing is by stopwatch. The leader board will be updated on a laptop, printed out and put on the notice board next to the timing team.

Points: Competitors will score points up to 30th place.

Combined points awarded for the Motorkhana and the Autocross will determine the overall placings. Certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be presented for each class and the overall winner. Additional awards may be presented at the organiser's discretion.

9. FIRST AID & FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

The First aid officer will be stationed at the start line with the officials.

Fire Extinguishers will be at the Start Line, and at nominated points around the course.

10. SPECTATORS.

Spectators are welcome but by pedestrian access only. Due to lack of space near the circuit all spectator cars must be parked either in the clubrooms car park or on Kawakawa Road. All spectators

and competitors are to keep 5 metres clear of the block wall separating the 3km circuit from the 1.5km circuit.
