5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING

5.1. Licencing Requirements

- The driver must hold as a minimum a National Race (C1 or C2) Grade Competition Licence
- If the Entrant is not the driver, a Licenced Entrant's licence in the name of the Licenced Entrant is required.

5.2 New Drivers

Any drivers who have not previously competed at the Manfeild Race Circuit must indicate the fact on their entry form and attend the New Drivers Briefing session. The New Drivers briefing will be held in the Race Control Room, top floor of the Pit Lane Complex on Saturday 19th October at 0830hrs.

5.3 Competitor Understanding

In signing the entry form competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In Particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and Competitors obligations. as well as Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and the Code of Driving Conduct

6 DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

6.1 Scrutineering Audit Inspection

The Scrutineering Shed is midway along the Dummy Grid. Those requiring full audits need to present their vehicles and log books to the Scrutineers for inspection.

The scrutineers will be available at the following times:

Friday 18th October 2019 1300 - 1600hrs Saturday 19th October 2019 0730 - 0930hrs

6.2 <u>Documentation</u>

Will take place in the Track Office, ground floor of the pit lane complex. Competitors are required to bring proof of Club membership, current licences, vehicle log book and proof of payment. The Track Office is open for documentation:

Friday 18th October 2019 1300 – 1600hrs Saturday 19th October 2019 0730 - 0930hrs.

All competitors must have completed documentation and auditing prior to qualifying.

7 POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS

Pursuant to the National Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 120 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

Should there be less than 10 entries received for any of the classes proposed in Invited Classes of these Supplementary Regulations by the closing date, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that class or amalgamate it with another class at their sole discretion.

8 TRANSPONDER TIMING

- Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. Transponder hire is \$46 for the meeting
- If you own your own, or are borrowing a transponder please ensure the transponder number is entered into the transponder tab of vehicle details on your personal profile on www.possum.motorsport.org.nz. Failure to do so will result in an automatic transponder hire charge of \$46.
- No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is working and fitted correctly. You will be spoken to by a CRO if your transponder is not operating.
- Loss or damage to a hire transponder will be at the hirer's expense.
- Race timing is by AMB Transponder. Live timing will be available on Race Monitor and Mylaps Speedhive. Provisional results will be published to www.mylaps.com at the conclusion of the meeting











Race Monitor

We recommend that you purchase the **Race Monitor** or **Mylaps Speedhive app** for your iPhone or Android. It costs about \$7 and gives you live race reports plus day schedules up to 7 days prior and on the day of the meeting.

9 BRIEFINGS

9.1 Class Coordinators briefing

All class coordinators will meet with the Clerk of the Course in the Event Director's Office Level 2 of the Pit Lane Complex at 0800hrs on Saturday 19th October.

9.2 Drivers Briefing

A Written Drivers Briefing will be emailed to Class Coordinators prior to the event for distribution to their members. It will also be available at documentation.

There will be no oral drivers briefing. Each class will hold their own briefing with instructions provided by the Clerk of the Course

The New Drivers briefing will be held in the Race Control Room, top floor of the Pit Lane Complex on Saturday 19th October at 0830hrs.

10 GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1 Set up times/ Track Opening and Closing

- The facility has been hired by the Manawatu Car Club from Saturday 19th October 2019/to Sunday 20th October 2019 only. If you wish to set up earlier please contact the Manfeild Park Office on 06 323 7444 or Jeff Braid on 027 477 3337.
- The gates and the Stadium will be unlocked at 7am on Saturday and Sunday mornings.
- The gates and the Stadium will be locked at 7pm on Friday and Saturday.
- The circuit must be completely vacated on Sunday at the conclusion of the event. Anyone wanting otherwise must make prior arrangements with the Manfeild Park Office.

10.2 Limited Pit Space

With 12 grids competing at this year's OctoberFAST!, teams are requested to cooperate with each other to fit everyone in. The grass areas may be too soft for pitting. We have use of the whole of the Stadium car park. Please instruct any visitors or team guests not to drive into the pits. Service vehicles only will be permitted in the pit paddock area. All other cars are to park in the Rata Street grass car park or the Stadium car park.

10.3 Trailer Parking

All open trailers must be removed to the designated trailer parking area near behind the Manfeild stadium.

10.4 Site Access

Access to the circuit is via both the Rata Street Entrance and the South Street Entrance via Brendon Hartley Drive.

10.5 Friday Testing

- Friday 18th October is a public test day run by the Manfeild Park starting at 0900 and finishing at 1700. Lunch break is from 1200hrs to 1230hrs.
- The cost is \$140 payable at sign-on in the Track Office. There is no half-day rate. A passenger fee of \$40 also applies.
- Entry to the test day is via Rata Street and South Street.

10.6 Fuel Availability

No fuel is available at the circuit. No fuel is to be stored fuel in your pits overnight. See 13 FUEL.

10.7 <u>Meeting Rides</u>

Meeting Rides may be conducted at the conclusion of racing on Saturday 19th October2019, time and conditions dependent. This will be at the sole discretion of the Meeting organisers. Meeting rides will be run according to Appendix Four Schedule Z Article 24. The Rules/Guidelines will be available in the Track Office. Passenger indemnity Forms must be completed and returned to the Meeting Secretary by 1500 on Saturday 19th October.

10.8 Charity Lunchtime Circuit Cruise

At the discretion of the organisers a Charity Circuit Cruise will be run during the lunch breaks on Saturday and Sunday. All proceeds will be donated to Manchester House Suicide Awareness. The Cruise is open to road cars only. All drivers must pay \$10, sign an indemnity form and wear a wristband to participate. Drivers will follow the Safety Car for several laps of Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon. Passengers must be wearing safety belts at all times. Further instructions will be provided on sign-up.

10.9 Pit Paddock and Pit Lane Rules

- Animals are NOT allowed within the Manfeild Park facility.
- No person under the age of 14 is allowed in the Pit Lane area unless a competitor.
- Covered footwear MUST be worn in the Pit Lane area.
- WORN RACE TYRES AND CAR PARTS must be removed from the venue by the competitor.
- **USED OIL** is to be disposed of in the oil recovery tank in the Scrutineering Shed.

- **ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES** in use at the venue must be tagged and tested according to the requirements in Regulation 26 of the Electrical (Safety) Regulations 2010.
- PIT BIKES, QUAD BIKES AND SIDE-BY SIDES may only be operated by licenced drivers wearing approved helmets.
