COVID CATCH-UP SEALED AUTOCROSS

Supplementary Regulations for Sealed Autocross Saturday 29th August 2020

1. JURISDICTION

This is a Clubsport Basic event promoted by the Manawatu Car Club (0361).

This event is held under the MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code Appendix 5, Schedule C.

3. VENUE

Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon 3.03km circuit, Feilding. Surface is sealed. All entry is via the Rata Street entrance.

NOTE: Under Covid-19 Restrictions the venue limit is a maximum of 100 people. The gate will be controlled to ensure no more than 100 are on site at any one time.

All competitors, crew and others attending the meeting must complete the Covid-19 Track and Trace Register on arrival to the circuit. For further Covid-19 requirements see 13. below.

4. ENTRIES & FEES

ALL competitors MUST complete the NON-CONTACT ONLINE ENTRY FORM on the website

www.manawatucarclub.org.nz . NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF THE MEETING.

The entry fee is \$120 inc GST. Discount for Manawatu Car Club members. Normal entries close on Friday 28th August 2020.

5. CLASSES, ELIGIBILITY & LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Classes:

- Rookie (new to competition in 2018)
- NARWD- normally aspirated rear-wheel-drive
- NAFWD- normally aspirated front-wheel-drive
- FI + NA2WD over 3500cc- forced induction vehicles and normally aspirated 2 wheel-drive over 3500c

5.2 Eligibility: All cars must comply with Schedule A Safety. Road cars with current registration and WOF are permitted. BOS cars are permitted.

5.3 Licences

- i) No MSNZ competition licence is required.
- ii) No MSNZ membership is required if you have competed at 2 events or fewer. New competitors are to enter the Rookie class.
- iii) Drivers 12years and older are eligible to compete with parental consent.

6. PASSENGERS. Due to Covid-19 Social Distancing requirements passengers are not permitted

7. DOCUMENTATION, AUDIT SCRUTINEERING & DRIVERS BRIEFING

Documentation will commence at **0800** and finish at **0930 at the Manfeild Track Office, ground floor of the Pit Lane Complex**. Competitors will line up outside the track office separated by 2 metres. Drivers will complete their documentation one at a time by entering the track office via the main entrance door and exiting onto the pit lane.

Scrutineering will take place in the Scrutineering Shed on the Dummy Grid. Audits as per MSNZ requirements. All cars without a Competition Vehicle Logbook must be audited. Audits will take place on the day from 0800 to 0930. Teams are to observe Covid-19 protocols when presenting their vehicles to the scrutineers.

A socially distanced drivers briefing will take place at the outside stairs of the Pit Lane Complex at **0930 and is compulsory for all competitors. Drivers are requested to wear face coverings and stand at least 1m apart.**

8. FIRST AID, RESCUE & FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

First aid Officer will be stationed in pit lane adjacent to pit gates

The Rescue Crew will be stationed in the pit lane near the pit exit

4.5kg Fire Extinguishers will be at the Start Line, at nominated points around the course and in the recovery vehicles.

9. RUNS

The Autocross run will be a lap of the 3.03 km track using connecting link roads for an overall length of around 4km. Two layouts will be used, one in the morning and the other in the afternoon. Competitors will be released from the pit lane exit to begin the run with flying start across the Start/Finish Line and will end in a flying finish across the same line. Competitors will negotiate chicanes positioned on the course in compliance with Appendix 5 Schedule C 2.1(1). A knocked over cone adds 5sec to the competitor's time.

Up to four vehicles may be running at any one time but at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Up to three official runs per competitor will be timed in each layout. The best single run in each layout counts. All competitors must have completed the first run before the next run starts and so on. Additional runs will not count towards the results.

Competitors will complete a sighting run in single file behind the course car before commencing the morning and afternoon runs

Results will be based on the aggregate of the best morning and the best afternoon run. In the event of a draw the competitor who set the time first will prevail.

10. TIMING AND RESULTS.

Timing will be by AMB transponder. These will be issued to drivers at documentation. There is no hire charge and they must be returned at the conclusion of the event.

Running results will be live on the Race Monitor live timing app. Results will be posted on the Manawatu Car Club Facebook page. To avoid person-to-person contact no printed results will be issued.

Final results will be posted on the website www.manawatucarclub.org.nz

11. PRIZE GIVING

There will be no prize giving at the conclusion of competition. Certificates and prizes will be delivered to the winners after the event

12. PITS GARAGES AND PARKING.

Competitor parking and pits are in the Manfeild paddock area. The stable pit bays are free and are available on a first-in-first-served basis. Garage hire is available. Please contact Jeff Braid 027 4773337 for details.
