



## Pararorangi Road Rallysprint

### Supplementary Regulations

This event will be held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of Motorsport New Zealand and any relevant regulations prescriptions or specifications relating thereto as contained in the current NZ Motorsport Manual and amendments and these Supplementary Regulations, namely Appendix Three, Schedule RS- Rallysprints.

#### **3. THE EVENT**

- 3.1. Venue - the event will be held on Venue: Pararorangi Road, Waituna West, Feilding, with documentation at the event HQ situated just before the start line on the bridge.
- 3.2. Length the course is approx. 5.5kms. 100% gravel. The road will be run in one direction only, with cars touring back down to the start in convoy.
- 3.3. Event Schedule
  - 0800-0845 Documentation/set up
  - 0845 Briefing
  - 0900 Recce run commences
  - 0930 Practice run commences, followed by timed runs.
  - 1600 – 1700 Course cleared and packed up
- 3.4. All vehicles are eligible for all runs. There will be no elimination runs.
- 3.5. Results for the day will be the fastest of any of the runs held on the day.
- 3.6. Official and Observations Runs - there will be one practice run and 3 timed runs. The number of runs will be dependent upon the total number of entries received, and force majeure on the day.
- 3.7. The timings are tight throughout the day, any breakdowns etc will be handled as efficiently as we can, this may mean a car is moved to a safe spot and towed back on the return pass to allow the day to run on time.
- 3.8. Service Park is in the paddock on the left hand side of the road just before the bridge ( grid reference 40°03'14.6"S 175°35'57.3"E ). Space is limited so please be considerate with parking. Trailers can be left on the roadside with due care.

#### **4. ENTRIES**

- 4.1. Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close on Wednesday 17th March 2020. For seeding and scrutineering purposes no entries will be accepted after Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2021.
- 4.2. Entry shall be made on the Official Entry Form online system via the Manawatu Car Club website ([www.manawatucarclub.org.nz](http://www.manawatucarclub.org.nz)) and to be deemed valid, must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. Acceptance will be at the Organisers discretion.
- 4.3. Entry Fee will be \$150 per entry. Payment can be made by credit card or direct credit
- 4.4. Dual Entries will only be accepted if the number of entries allows.
- 4.5. The maximum number of entries accepted will be 35. As this is Round 2 of the Central Region Sprint Series, competitors registered for the series will be given priority. If needed a reserve list will be started

#### **5. CLASSES**

- Class A 2WD 0-1400cc
- Class B 2WD 1400-1750cc
- Class C 2WD 1751cc and over
- Class D 4WD – manufactured after Jan.1st 1996 & all 4WD not eligible for Class E
- Class E 4WD – Pre-1996

Wof and Rego is not compulsory for this event

All vehicles will be scrutineered to Appendix Three Schedule RS 5.1, including additional requirements found in Appendix Two Schedule A 7.

#### **6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT**

Documentation will be held at the event HQ on the day from 8.00am to 8.45am. Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of documents and logbooks. Non registered competitors will be issued numbers at documentation.

- 6.1 This Event will be run using Remote scrutineering system  
Competitors are to arrange with one of the scrutineers on the list below to perform a scrutineering audit within the 8 days prior to the event. Audits may be carried out from the 12th March 2021 and inspections carried out no later than the 17<sup>th</sup> March 2021. Others may be added at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer. If you wish to use a scrutineer not listed below contact the Chief Scrutineer.

#### **7. RALLY SPRINT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

This event is being held as a rally sprint to make it easier for the organisers. The structure of the day will still be similar to previous Engine Room Series events. There are a few extra requirements for competitors - including (but not limited to):

- Must carry a passenger. Make sure they understand the safety procedures and expectations.
- Extra clothing - Balaclava and gloves. Check your overalls
- First aid kit
- 2kg total fire extinguisher
- Safety triangle & SOS/OK sign

- Tow rope

## 8. DRIVERS BRIEFING

A verbal briefing will be given at the Start Line of the venue at 8.45am. A roll call will be held, all drivers are required to attend.

## 9. OBSERVATION RUN

There will be an observation convoy run. You may make your own notes but please do not hold up the run while doing so. Please treat the practice run as a PRACTICE, although it will be timed it does not count for the final results.

## 10. TIMING

Cars will start at one-minute intervals via countdown lights. The clocks used will be accurate to 0.01 seconds (1/100ths)

## 11. ACCIDENT DAMAGE

If you do cause damage to fences or other property you must advise an Official at the HQ situated adjacent to the Start Line. You will be charged for cost of repairs at the cost charged to the Club.

## 12. RUN NOTES AND RECONNAISSANCE

## 13. CAR NUMBERS

Any car numbers that are issued to you are the property of the Dannevirke Car Club. You are required to return them to the HQ BEFORE you leave the venue. If they are not returned you will be sent an account for \$25.00 per number for their replacement. Please ensure you have tape to affix them to both sides of your car in a clear to read position
