

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATION'S PART 1 & 2

1. JURISDICTION

This is a National Race Meeting promoted by the Manawatu Car Club Inc. The meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport N.Z. National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly:

- Appendix Four, Schedule Z, the Standing Regulations for all Race Meetings and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C, the Standing Regulations for Clubsport Events and
- Appendix Two, Schedule A Driver Safety and Vehicle Requirements and
- MotorSport NZ approved articles & technical regulations applicable to the competing Championship and Accredited Series Classes.

The Written Drivers Briefing for this meeting carries the authority of these Supplementary Regulations. **MotorSport NZ Permit numbers: 220155 and 220162**

2. Covid -19 IMPORTANT REMINDER TO ALL COMPETITORS AND THEIR CREWS

New Zealand Government

This meeting will be run under Covid 19 restrictions, using the Motorsport NZ Back in Motion Guidelines <u>https://www.motorsport.org.nz/wp-</u> <u>content/uploads/Back-in-Motion.pdf</u>

All New Zealand is under "Red" at the time of publishing. Anyone intending on entering the venue each day must be able to show their valid My Vaccine Pass verification to the security staff at the entrance gate. If you do not have a valid My Vaccine Pass you will not be able to enter the venue.

In line with recent changes to the MSNZ COVID-19 Protection Framework, all events now require face masks to be worn at all times except for when the driver is in their competition vehicle.

Groups are to remain within their designated 'Defined Spaces' marked by the orange temporary fencing. The boundaries are shown on the attached site map. Coloured wristbands will be issued for each space on arrival.

All attendees are advised to be prepared. Make a plan for how to get home to isolate if you get COVID-19 if you can travel there safely. You will only be able to return home if you or someone you are travelling with are able to drive. If not, you will need to stay in place for your isolation period.

6. Mitre10 MEGA Summer Series Classes Series Rules

SF Cup	From 1:25.000 to 1:29.999	10 minutes qualifying, 6 laps scratch, 6 laps reverse grid, 6 laps handicap
RS Cup	Slower than 1:30.000	10 minutes qualifying, 6 laps scratch, 6 laps reverse grid, 6 laps handicap

- Scratch Race: Positions will be determined by qualifying times, fastest to slowest
- Reverse Grid Race: Positions will be the reverse of the actual finishing order of the first race per class
- Handicap Race: Handicap positions will be arranged from slowest to fastest, based on the second fastest lap time set in qualifying and all races during the day

6.1 Merging Classes: The organisers reserve the right to merge classes to promote competitive racing. Separate class points and penalties will still apply.

6.2 GT-B, IB Cup, SF Cup and RS Cup Time Penalty Rules

If you qualify faster than the nominated fastest lap time for your class, you will automatically lose 50 championship points. If you go faster than the nominated fastest lap time for your class in any of the 3 races during the day the following penalty will apply:

- For each lap faster by 0 1.000 seconds in any one race a penalty of 10 seconds will be added to your total race time.
- For each lap faster by 1.001 2.000 seconds in any one race a penalty of 20 seconds will be added to your total race time.
- For each lap faster by 2.001 3.000 in any one race, a penalty of 30 seconds will be added to your total race time.

During the race if you break out you will be notified. The time penalty will also be noted on the race results. No separate time penalty notice will be issued.

For GT-B, IB Cup, SF Cup and RS Cup competitors who exceed the minimum lap time more than twice in any qualifying session or race, the competitor will be instructed by the Clerk of the Course to transfer to the next faster class but with their points intact.

For GT-A, GT-B, IB Cup, SF Cup competitors who are too slow reach the maximum lap time in all sessions the competitor will be instructed by the Clerk of the Course to transfer to the next slower class but with their points intact.

6.3 In-Car Lap Timers For GT-B, IB Cup, SF Cup and RS Cup

In-car lap timing devices are prohibited. Data loggers, lap timers, countdown timers, cell phones or any similar device that provides live information must not operate. Their displays must be removed during official qualifying and races. No pit-to-driver communication is permitted during qualifying and races. Failure to comply will result in the loss of all points accumulated in the meeting.

Competitors are subject to random inspection by scrutineers at any time within the duration of the event permit.

*This rule is to prevent erratic and dangerous driving that has been employed by some competitors to keep above target lap times to avoid a penalty.

6.4 Determining the winner of GT Cup

GT Cup has been split into GT-A and GT-B. The target lap times have also been split for each sub-group. Competitors will accumulate points according to their respective speed group and according to Item 12. Series Points (see below). The highest points-scorer will win the overall trophy for the class. E.g.: if the GT-B winner has the highest GT points total that driver will win the GT Cup.

6.5 Sponsor decals

All Mitre10 MEGA classes are required to fix MITRE 10 MEGA decals on both front guards of the car. **6.6 Mitre10 MEGA Summer Series Points**

Series points for all Classes will be awarded from 1st place to 30th place on the following scale: 75,67,60,54,49,45,42,39,36,33,30,28,26,24,22,20,18,16,14,12,10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1.

Any ties will be resolved by countback, firstly to the driver with the highest number of round wins. In the case of a further tie the highest number of first placings, second placings and so on until a winner has been determined.

7. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING

Licencing Requirements

- The driver must hold as a minimum a National Race (C1 or C2) Grade Competition Licence
- If the Entrant is not the driver, a Licenced Entrant's licence in the name of the Licenced Entrant is required.

New Drivers

Any drivers who have not previously competed at the Manfeild Race Circuit or have not completed 3 race meetings must indicate the fact on their entry and attend the New Drivers Briefing session. The New Drivers briefing will be held in the Race Control Room, top floor of the Pit Lane Complex on Friday 1st, Saturday 2nd and Sunday 3rd at 0830hrs. N.B. Please see below for your classes briefing day. <u>Competitor Understanding</u>

In signing the entry form competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In Particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and Competitor's obligations. as well as Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and the Code of Driving Conduct

8. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

8.1 Scrutineering Audit Inspection

The Scrutineering Shed is midway along the Dummy Grid. Those requiring full audits need to present their vehicles and logbooks to the Scrutineers for inspection. Face masks are to be worn inside the scrutineering shed.

The scrutineers will be available at the following times:

- a. Friday 1st April 0800 1600
- b. Saturday 2nd April 0800 0930
- c. Sunday 3rd April 0800 0930

8.2 Documentation

Documentation will take place by signing in on arrival at the gate. Competitors are to have Club membership, current licences, and vehicle logbook ready for inspection.

All competitors **must** have completed documentation and vehicle safety audits prior to qualifying.

9. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS

Pursuant to the National Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 120 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

Should there be less than 10 entries received for any of the classes proposed in Invited Classes of these Supplementary Regulations by the closing date, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that class or amalgamate it with another class at their sole discretion.

10. TRANSPONDER TIMING

Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. Transponder hire is \$20 for the meeting If you own your own, or are borrowing a transponder please ensure the transponder number is included in your entry

No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is working and fitted correctly. You will be spoken to by a CRO if your transponder is not operating.

Loss or damage to a hire transponder will be at the hirer's expense.

Race timing is by AMB Transponder. Live timing will be available on Race Monitor and My laps Speed hive. Provisional results will be published on the Manawatu Car Club Facebook page and loaded onto <u>www.mylaps.com</u> at the conclusion of the meeting

12. GENERAL INFORMATION

a. Set up times/ Track Opening and Closing

The facility has been hired by the Manawatu Car Club from Friday 1st to Sunday 3rd April 2022 only. If you wish to set up earlier, please contact the Manfeild Park Office on 06 323 7444 or Jeff Braid on 027 477 3337.

The gates will be unlocked at 7am each morning.

The gates will be locked at 7pm on Friday and Saturday.

The circuit must be completely vacated on Sunday at the conclusion of the event. Anyone wanting otherwise must make prior arrangements.

b. Limited Pit Space/ Defined Spaces

All teams are requested to co-operate with each other to fit everyone in within their Defined Spaces. Service vehicles only will be permitted in the pit paddock area. All other cars are to park in the Stadium car park.

c. Trailer Parking

All open trailers must be removed to Manfeild Stadium Carpark as per the pit plan.

d. Site Access

Access to the circuit is via both the Rata Street Entrance and the South Street Entrance via Brendon Hartley Drive.

e. Friday Testing

Friday Test Day starts at 0900 and finishes at 1700. Lunch break is from 1200 to 1230 The cost is \$120 payable online at https://manawatucarclub.org.nz/product-category/payments/ Access to the test day is via Rata Street and South Street.

f. Fuel Availability

No fuel is available at the circuit. No fuel is to be stored fuel in your pits overnight. See 13 FUEL.

g. Pit Paddock and Pit Lane Rules

Animals are NOT allowed within the Manfeild Park facility.

No person under the age of 14 is allowed in the Pit Lane area unless a competitor.

Covered footwear MUST be worn in the Pit Lane area.

WORN RACE TYRES AND CAR PARTS must be removed from the venue by the competitor.

USED OIL is to be disposed of in the oil recovery tank in the Scrutineering Shed.

ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES in use at the venue must be tagged and tested according to the requirements in Regulation 26 of the Electrical (Safety) Regulations 2010.

PIT BIKES, QUAD BIKES AND SIDE-BY SIDES may only be operated by licenced drivers wearing approved helmets.
