- MotorSport NZ approved articles & technical regulations applicable to the competing Championship and Accredited Series Classes.

3. ENTRY, CLOSING DATE, ENTRY FEES AND TICKETS

3.2. Tickets. Each competitor will be issued with four(4) tickets at documentation. Public spectator admission is \$10 per day on Saturday and Sunday. Friday is free.

3.3. Entry Fee Refunds Policy

The Organisers advise that entry fee will **only be refunded in full or in part** under the following conditions:

- Non-acceptance of entry
- Cancellation of the meeting prior to commencement of documentation
- Withdrawal in writing prior to close of normal entries
- Withdrawal after normal entry closing but before the start time listed for documentation

The organisers confirm the entry **fees will not be refunded** for the following:

- Withdrawals or failure of a competitor to advise of non-appearance at the meeting after the commencement of Qualifying
- Abandonment or Cancellation of the meeting after the commencement of Documentation

5. **COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING**

5.1. **Licencing Requirements**

- The driver must hold as a minimum a National Race (C1 or C2) Grade Competition Licence
- If the Entrant is not the driver, a Licenced Entrant's licence in the name of the Licenced Entrant is required.

5.2 **New Drivers**

Any drivers who have not previously competed at the Manfeild Race Circuit must indicate the fact on their entry and attend the New Drivers Briefing session. **The New Drivers briefing will be held in the Race Control Room, level 2 of the Pit Lane Complex on Saturday 22nd October at 0830.**

5.3 **Competitor Understanding**

In signing the entry form competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In Particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and Competitors obligations. as well as Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and the Code of Driving Conduct

6 **DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION**

6.1 **Scrutineering Audit Inspection**

6.1.1 The Scrutineering Shed is midway along the Dummy Grid. Those requiring full audits need to present their vehicles and logbooks to the Scrutineers for inspection.

The scrutineers will be available at the following times:

Friday 21st October 2022 0900 - 1600

Saturday 22nd October 2022 0800 – 0930

6.1.2 Remote Audits are authorised for this event. As OctoberFAST! is the first round in many of the competing series, competitors are encouraged to use remote scrutineering where possible to avoid delays at the event.

Remote scrutineering will be available in the following regions from 7th October, (14) fourteen days out from the start of the event.

Please contact one of the listed Scrutineers. In addition to presenting the competing vehicle be sure to include the competition vehicle logbook and all safety apparel.

6.2 Documentation Will take place in the Secretary's Office, on the right of the Dummy Grid near the pit gate. Competitors are required to bring proof of Club membership, current licences, vehicle logbook. The Secretary's Office is open for documentation:

All competitors **must** have completed documentation and auditing prior to qualifying.

7 POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS

Pursuant to the National Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 120 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

Should there be less than 10 entries received for any of the classes proposed in Invited Classes of these Supplementary Regulations by the closing date, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that class or amalgamate it with another class at their sole discretion.

8 TRANSPONDER TIMING

- Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. Transponder hire is \$46 for the meeting
- **If you own your own, please ensure the transponder number is included in your entry**
- No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is working and fitted correctly. You will be spoken to by a CRO if your transponder is not operating. Failure to remedy will result in no timing for your vehicle.
- Loss or damage to a hire transponder will be at the hirer's expense.
- Live timing will be available on Race Monitor and Mylaps Speedhive. Provisional results will be published to www.mylaps.com at the conclusion of the meeting

9 BRIEFINGS

9.1 Class Coordinators briefing

All class coordinators will meet with the Clerk of the Course in the Event Director's Office Level 2 of the Pit Lane Complex at 0800hrs on Saturday 24th October.

9.2 Drivers Briefing

A Written Drivers Briefing will be emailed to Class Coordinators prior to the event for distribution to their members. It will also be available at documentation.

9.3 New Drivers Briefing will be held in the Race Control Room, Level 2 of the Pit Lane Complex on Saturday 22nd October at 0830. Any other drivers new to Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon must also attend.

9.4 Full Drivers Briefing will be held by the outside steps of the Pit Lane Building at 0900 on Saturday 24th October.

10 GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1 Set up times/ Track Opening and Closing

- The facility has been hired by the Manawatu Car Club from Friday 21st to Sunday 23rd October 2022 only. If you wish to set up Thursday please contact the Manfeild Park Office on 06 323 7444 or Jeff Braid on 027 477 3337.
- The gates will be unlocked at 7am each morning.
- The gates will be locked at 7pm on Friday and Saturday.
- The circuit must be completely vacated on Sunday at the conclusion of the event. Anyone wanting to do otherwise must make prior arrangements with Manfeild Park Trust.

10.2 MACK Trucks 50th Anniversary Event and Truck Show will be held in the Manfeild Park Stadium and stadium car park on Friday and Saturday, concluding with a track parade of Mack trucks after the end of racing on Saturday. Admission to the Truck Show is included with entry to OctoberFAST!

10.3 Limited Pit Space

With the Mack Truck Show and 10 grids competing at this year's OctoberFAST! teams are requested to co-operate with each other to fit everyone in. Some of the grass areas may be too soft for pitting. Please instruct any visitors or team guests not to drive into the pits They are to park in the public car parks. Service vehicles only will be permitted in the paddock area. All other cars are to park in the Rata Street grass car park, or off the main entrance on Brendon Hartley Drive.

10.4 Trailer Parking

All open trailers must be removed to the designated trailer parking area near behind the Manfeild stadium.

10.5 Site Access

Access to the circuit is via both the Rata Street Entrance and the South Street Entrance via Brendon Hartley Drive.

10.6 Friday Testing

- Friday 23rd October Test Day starts at 0900 and finishes at 1600. Lunch break is from 1200 to 1230
- The cost is \$120 payable online at <https://manawatucarclub.org.nz/product-category/payments/>
- All drivers must sign in at the Secretary's Office before commencing testing
- Access to the test day is via Rata Street and South Street.

10.7 **Fuel Availability**

No fuel is available at the circuit. No fuel is to be stored fuel in your pits overnight. See 13 FUEL.

10.8 **Charity Lunchtime Circuit Cruise**

At the discretion of the organisers a Charity Circuit Cruise will be run during the lunch break on Sunday. All proceeds will be donated to Manchester House Suicide Awareness. The Cruise is open to road cars only. All drivers must pay \$10, sign an indemnity form and wear a wristband to participate. Drivers will follow the Safety Car for several laps of Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon. Passengers must be wearing safety belts at all times. Further instructions will be provided on sign-up.

10.9 **Pit Paddock and Pit Lane Rules**

- Animals must be on a leash within the Manfeild Park facility.
- No person under the age of 14 is allowed in the Pit Lane area unless a competitor.
- Up to three (3) team members for each vehicle continuing in the practice or race will be permitted in the signalling bay
- Covered footwear MUST be worn in the Pit Lane area.
- **WORN RACE TYRES AND CAR PARTS** must be removed from the venue by the competitor.
- **USED OIL** is to be disposed of in the oil recovery tank in the Scrutineering Shed.
- **ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES** in use at the venue must be tagged and tested according to the requirements in Regulation 26 of the Electrical (Safety) Regulations 2010.
- **PIT BIKES, QUAD BIKES AND SIDE-BY SIDES** may only be operated by licenced drivers wearing approved helmets.

11 **CAMPING**

Overnight camping is allowed on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. There are numerous caravan-type and 3-point power outlets in the paddock area.
