



## KANSEI JULY SOLO DRIFT COMPETITION

### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS Parts 1 and 2

#### 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Clubsport Basic Event, promoted by the Manawatu Car Club Inc at Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule DR being the Standing Regulations for Drift Events, and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

#### 3. EVENT LOCATION:

Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon 3km track. The judged section will be from the entry to Turn 3 to the entry to the Hairpin.

#### 4. JUDGING CRITERIA

The event will be a solo drift competition where each solo pass will be judged on:

- Line
- Initiation
- Style
- Angle

Each member of the judging panel will award a score for each pass. The scores will be added together to arrive at the total score for the pass.

#### 5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING

This is a Clubsport Basic event. All drivers must hold a current club membership of a Member club, except for new entrants to motorsport who may compete in two(2) Basic Status Events before being required to join a club. A competition licence is not required.

## 6. COMPETITOR UNDERSTANDING

In submitting the entry competitors are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and Appendix Five, Schedule C and Schedule DR.

## 7. ENTRIES

Online entries and payments are to be made via the Manawatu Car Club Online entry system [Online Entry and Online Payment](#)

Entries close on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July. Late entries may be accepted at the organisers' discretion. Entry fee is \$220. Discount for Manawatu Car Club members

## 8. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

All vehicles shall conform to the vehicle safety regulations contained in Appendix Two [Schedule A](#) and [Schedule DR](#)

**Note:** Competitors should be familiar with and adhere to the MotorSport NZ Code of Practice – Fuel, which is available on the MotorSport NZ website (<https://motorsport.org.nz/technical/fuel/>)

## 9. DOCUMENTATION AND VEHICLE SAFETY AUDITS

Documentation will take place in the Secretary's office to the right of the Dummy Grid from 08:00 to 09:30

Vehicle Safety Audits will be in the Scrutineering Shed midway down the Dummy Grid from 07:30 to 09:30

## 10. DRIVERS BRIEFING

**All competition drivers must attend the drivers briefing in the Race Control Room on Level 2 of the Pit Lane Complex at 0900. There will be a rollcall. The judges will explain the scoring criteria.**

## 11. COMPETITION FORMAT

- Morning free practice.
- 1230 Open Pit with judged runs. Assemble in the right lane at the Start/Finish Line.
- Cars will be released at regular intervals for solo run judging.
- Maximum of 10 judged runs
- The best four(4) judged run scores totalled counts for the results
- In the event of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> – 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> the judges will call a One More Time solo run decider.

## 12. PRIZES

Prizes and trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place winners at the conclusion of the competition.

## 13. MATARIKI DRIFT PRACTICE

Drift Practice for non-competing drivers will run concurrently with Kansei Solo Drift. At the Start/Finish Line Single runners on the left, tandem runners in the centre. Judged competition runners will be lined up on the right.

Expression Session runs may follow after the conclusion of the Kansei Solo Competition if there is time.

#### 14. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **STABLES:** Pit bays are first-in-first-served.
