SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PARTS ONE & TWO

EVENT OVERVIEW: The aim of the meeting is to offer our club racers the discipline of longer-format race events. The emphasis is on FUN and lots of seat-time. You have permission to enjoy yourselves. The races are divided into Clubmans Race Escargot, and National Race Rapide. This meeting will host Round 2 of MX5RacingNZ Winter MX5 Cup. The classes are described below.

NZ Six will be running their National Round with North and South Island drivers competing for the title.

We are also sharing the weekend with the NZ Superkart Drivers Championship Series Nationals Kartsport NZ officials will manage their events.

1. JURISDICTION:

This event is a National Race Meeting and a Clubmans Race Meeting, promoted by the Manawatu Car Club Inc. at Manfeild: Circuit Chris Amon on Saturday 20th and Sunday 21st of July 2024.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Four, Schedule Z being the Standing Regulations for all Race Meetings and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

Acceptance of Entry

Given that this is a "low key" meeting no formal acceptance of entry will be posted. Competitors can therefore assume that provided they have completed an online entry fully and included with it the appropriate entry fee that the organisers will accept the entry.

4. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS & UNDERSTANDING:

• Licence Requirements:

The driver must hold as a minimum a C1 Grade Competition Licence. If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

• Competitors Briefing:

A written briefing will be issued online and will be available at documentation for all competitors. A verbal drivers' briefing will be held in the Scrutineering Shed prior to the first Qualifying Session on Saturday at 12:30pm

New Drivers:

Any driver(s) who are racing at one of their first three(3) race events or who have not previously competed at the circuit must indicate the fact on the entry form and attend the New Competitors Briefing session. This briefing will take place after the main drivers briefing in the Race Control Room on Level 2 of the Pit Lane Complex

Competitor understanding:

In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations, and Schedule Z Articles detailing Flag signals and Code of Driving Conduct. Refer to Competitor Resources.

5. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION:

Documentation:

Will take place at the Secretary's Office commencing at 0800 on Saturday 20^{th} July and concluding at 1100.

Scrutineering Audit Inspection:

These inspections will occur concurrently with documentation on Saturday 20th July. If your vehicle is due an audit go directly to the Scrutineering Shed first prior to documentation.

6. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

The organisers reserve the right to cancel or abandon the meeting or part thereof should less than the minimum number of entries as prescribed in the regulations/articles not be achieved. The minimum number is 30(forty) entries

For reasons of Force Majeure should a meeting or part thereof be cancelled any entry fee refund, full or partial, will be made only at the discretion of the organisers.

7. CLASSES

- Escargot. Clubmans Race class, with sub-classes for RS Cup no faster than 1:30.00 and SF Cup cars no faster than 1:25.00. SF Cup cars will be identified by a SF marking
- Rapide. National Race class, with sub-classes for IB Cup no faster than 1:20.00 and GT Cup no slower than 1:20.00. GT Cup cars will be identified by a GT marking
- Mazda MX5 class for MX5s that comply with the <u>2024 MX5RacingNZ Winter MX5 Cup Rules</u>.
- NZ Six. Accredited Series class according to <u>NZ Six North Island</u> and <u>South Island NZ Six</u> series articles.

8. EVENT FORMAT FOR ESCARGOT, RAPIDE AND MX5 CUP

- Practice sessions take place on Saturday morning.
- Qualifying sessions on Saturday afternoon
- One race on Saturday and two races on Sunday.
- Starting positions: Starting grid position for Escargot and Rapide grids shall be
 determined from the fastest times achieved in qualifying, Race 1 and Race 2 by each
 competing vehicle, fastest vehicle to the front.
- For MX5 Cup Race 1 Starting grid position shall be determined from the fastest times achieved in qualifying, Race 2 will be a full reverse grid based on the finish order of Race 1. Race 3 will be based on points gained in Race 1 and Race 2
- Starts: All starts will be rolling starts. The field will be released onto the circuit for the
 positioning lap and will stop in their grid positions. At the signal the field will follow the
 Safety Car on the formation lap ready for the race start
- Races will be run to a time of 23 minutes + 1 lap
- Performance Equalising Drive-Through:

To even up the race pace of Escargot cars, **SF Cup cars will be required to perform one** pit-lane drive-through within the signalled Drive-Through window.

To even up the race pace of Rapide cars, **GT Cup cars will be required to perform one pit-lane drive-through within the signalled Drive-Through window.**

The maximum speed of a Performance Equalising Drive Through is 40km/h Any additional performance driving equalising drive-throughs deemed necessary by the COTC, will be notified on MegaViz and/or the start line signalling board.

- All MX5Racing NZ cars MUST perform one pit-lane drive-through within the signalled Drive-through window.
- The Drive-Through window will open 5 minutes after the race start and close 15 minutes after the race start.
- In accordance with Appendix Four Schedule Z the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or delete any event or cancel any race.

9. 24MINUTES OF LEMANFEILD POINTS:

For each race the following points will be awarded:

10. NZ Six National Race Format:

Qualifying	15 minutes
Race 1	8 laps standing start based on qualifying
Race 2	8 laps standing start reverse top ten based on finishing order of Race One
Race 3	8 Laps standing start based on accumulated points from Race One and Race Two

11. RACE TIMING, MYLAPS SPEEDHIVE AND RESULTS

Race timing is by AMB Transponder. Live timing will be available on MyLaps Speedhive. Final results will be posted at the conclusion of the meeting

- **The Flat Pad Extension** beyond the Pit Lane Complex is reserved for NZ Superkarts assembly area and parc ferme.
