6. QUALIFYING

Each class will receive a maximum of 10 minutes Qualifying.

7. STARTING PROCEDURE

For all Handicap Race starts, Vehicles will proceed from the pits on a formation lap to the start grid. Drivers will form up on the grid in their allocated starting box (position). Cars will be started in groups at time gaps of no less than 5 seconds per flag drop. **You are to remain stationary in your grid position**. You will start the race when the starter drops the flag for your group of cars. Where a handicap group is not present, the start signal shall still be given for that group.

All Other Race starts:

As per <u>Schedule Z Article 8 Starts</u>

8. NOISE:

The Feilding Auto Electrical Winter Series meetings are Category B Noise events under the Manfeild Park Resource Consent. All cars must be fitted with an effective muffler during the course of the event. Cars exceeding 95dB(A) will be removed from the Circuit and only permitted to re-join the Meeting after the car has been sufficiently muffled.

9. COMPETITION NUMBERS

Competition numbers will be confirmed by the Event Secretary. In the case of duplicate numbers preference will be given to the competitor who enters the Series first. Competitors with subsequent duplicate numbers must confirm their race number before Qualifying and/or Racing

The provision of race numbers is the responsibility of the competitor. Competition numbers shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A 6.2, or shall be of acceptable size and contrast to be clearly legible to race officials when the vehicle is moving at race speed.

10. WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING

Competitors must inform the Event Secretary in person or in writing that they are withdrawing from the Meeting.

11. PIT PADDOCK AREA

In winter the grass zones may be too wet for parking. Please cooperate with each other to fit everyone onto the hard stand. Teams may be directed by officials to move open trailers away from the pit area to open up sealed spaces.

12. MANAWATU CAR CLUB TEST DAY

The Test Day is on Saturday 7th June from 9.00am – 4.00pm. Recovery and control services will be provided.

NOTE: Test days are separate to the race meetings. Drivers must sign in to each event. Testing fee is \$150.00 incl GST. Register and pay online at <u>Event Payments</u>.

Half-day testing after 1pm by negotiation.

13. RACE CIRCUIT WALK

Teams and drivers are permitted to undertake their Race Circuit walk on the Saturday afternoon at the conclusion of the Test Day. This must be cleared in advance by Race Control. All personnel participating in the Race Circuit walk must wear a **high visibility vest**.

14. EVENT AT MANFEILD PARK

Friday 6th and Saturday 7th June the Feilding Craft Market will be held in the Manfeild Stadium and carpark. All access to and from the circuit will be via Rata Street.
