SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS & SAFETY PLAN

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Manawatu Car Club event held under The Manawatu Car Club Inc liability insurance on Sunday 3rd November 2024 at Manfeild Circuit Chris Amon.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, and coincide with the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

- 2.3** **Entrance:** Entry to the event will be via Rata Street

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

- 3.1** The event will consist of:

4x groups of 15x competitors (group stickers will be given at documentation)
20-minute sessions per group

Drivers can come in during their session to change tyres, drivers or passengers and return for the remainder of their session.

- 3.2** **Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes on the day and drivers given their respective groupings at documentation. Competitors will select or advise their estimated lap times on entry to categorize groups.

- 3.3** **Lowest Class:** The lowest class will be deemed as an entry level class limited to 100kmph. Only parents of dependant drivers or driver trainers allowed in vehicles without roll cages and are limited to 100kmph.

- (1) – Saloons faster than 1:20:00 open (entry/number dependant split group)**
(2) – Saloons faster than 1:20:00 open
(3) - Saloons between 1:20:00 – 1:30:00
(4) – Saloons slower than 1:30:00 limited to 100kmph

4. ENTRIES:

- 4.1** Entries will be made through the Manawatu Car Club website www.manawatucarclub.org.nz

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Alternatively, entries may be submitted manually in 'hard copy' form on the day if event does not exceed number of competitors. All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all detail, and accompanied by the appropriate fees.



Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations on: Thursday 24th October 2024 and close on: Friday 1st November at 07:00pm

Entries received after registration closes and on the day are not subject to late fee's

4.3 Entry Fees:

The Entry fee for this event is \$150.00 including GST per competitor.

4.4 Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 60. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Licence Requirements:

No competition license is required. All drivers must hold a current club membership of a Member club, except for new entrants to motorsport, who may compete in two (2) events before being required to join a club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the event, entry and driver and vehicle requirements.

5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

6.2 All non MSNZ log booked vehicles will be issued a Manawatu Car Club Audit Book to document audit history and speed up audit processing for future events

**Vehicles require auditing at every 3rd event or 6months.*

6.3 No open wheelers.

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

7.1 Documentation: Will take place at the Secretary's Office located in the pits near the hotdog stands commencing at 7:30am and concluding at 9:30am.

7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Will take place in the green Scrutineering Shed located in the pits commencing at 7:30am and concluding at 9:30am
Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle is due for an audit.

7.3 Drivers' Briefing: This will be held at the bottom of stairs in the pitting area near race control tower commencing at 8:30am.

Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken to ensure complete attendance.

Written drivers briefing will be available



8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

8.1 The organisers advise that if less than 40 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

9. TIMING:

9.1 Timing is optional

9.2 Transponders are available to hire from the Manawatu Car Club for a fee of \$25.00

9.3 Competitors can use their own form of timing

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1 **Passengers:** May only be carried in full homologated caged vehicles and must wear the appropriate safety wear unless in undertaking driver training and entered in to the lowest timed group limited to 100kmph.

10.2 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition. If you are found to be under the influence of any substances you will be removed from the venue.
